What is the Client Advisory Board?

The Client Advisory Board (CAB) was formed as part of a federally-funded statewide initiative for Louisiana Integrated Treatment Services (LITS). The CAB represents the interests of clients, consumers, family members, and advocates who care about the treatment system for people with co-occurring substance abuse and mental disorders.

The CAB serves as an advisory panel to the Louisiana Behavioral Healthcare Taskforce, whose mission is to develop policies, procedures, and provide training and technical assistance to local agencies working towards treatment integration and improvement. The CAB is highly regarded for its leadership & influence in an unprecedented change process (state & local).

Roles & Responsibilities

CAB Membership is voluntary, and duties entail quarterly meetings (travel expense reimbursed), monthly toll-free conference calls, and occasional special LITS events. Additionally, each member determines how much time s/he can devote to local LITS activities. Many CAB members participate in local Steering Committees & Community Networking Groups to give and gain perspective on local adaptations to LITS.
